Bed Bug Management—One Step at a Time! Step 3: Vacuum Here, There, Everywhere

Vacuum often where people sleep.

- Use the crack and crevice tool in corners and on carpet edges ...
- ... and on mattress and box springs seams.
- Use the brush tool (brush hard!) to break loose bugs—and their tiny, hard to see eggs.









Plug the hose end with a thick, wadded towel so bugs won't sneak out.



Place vacuum bag in a trash bag or empty the canister into the bag.



Knot the bag tightly ...







... and put it in the trash—outside.



Wash the crevice tool, brush (and anything else you used) in hot, soapy water.
